





- March 26, 1876 The Victor Baptist Church was organized as a mission church of the Baptist Church of Muscatine, Iowa.
- * 1880 Regular Prayer Services were organized.
- * July, 1881 The members met in a school house across from the present building, two and one half miles south of Victor.
- * 1903 The present ediface was erected. The Church also voted to become independent.


To be more obedient to Christ's command to go into all the world, our church has emphasized the support of MISSIONS.




Present building completed.


The Present Situation





Two Adult Classes meet in the Auditorium.






