General Prayer Requests for our Missionaries:

Father, I plead that _____ will be filled with the Holy Spirit and will daily walk in His power (*Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit.-Eph. 5:18; So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature – Gal. 5:16.*)

I pray that _____ will speak the Word of God with boldness (*After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly. - Acts 4:31; Pray also for me, that whenever I open my mouth, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, Eph. 6:19.*)

I ask that _____ will present the gospel clearly to unbelievers (*Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should. Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. Col. 4:4.*)

I pray that You will make _____'s ministry exceedingly fruitful and that You will glorify Yourself through this ministry (*Finally, brothers, pray for us that the message of the Lord may spread rapidly and be honored, just as it was with you. 2 Thes. 3:1.*)

Lord, I pray that You will create in _____ a servant's heart. (*Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus... Phil 2*)

I ask that _____ will live and labor each day for the glory of God (*So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God. 1 Co 10:31.*)

Father, I plead that _____ will be a vessel through which the love of God can flow to others (*And hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out his love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us – Rom, 5:5; "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." - John 13:34-35.*)

Please grant _____ Your specific direction for his/her ministry (*Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him and he will do this: - Ps 37:5.*)

I pray that _____ will have a deeper and clearer understanding of the Word of God and relationship with Christ (*But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.* - John 16:13;)

Father, I plead that You will continually protect _____ from all harm and ask that You would strengthen _____ physically (*But the Lord stood at my side and gave me strength, so that through me the message might be fully proclaimed and all the Gentiles might hear it. And I was delivered from the lion's mouth.* - 2 Tim. 4:7).

I ask that You would grant _____ peace and assurance about the care of his/her family members that are left at home (*Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.* - 1 Peter 5:7).

Father, I pray that _____ would see people and things from Your perspective (*Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;* - Prov. 3:5)

I plead that _____ will have a renewed and growing zeal to share the gospel with unbelievers (*That is why I am so eager to preach the gospel also to you who are at Rome. I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile* - Rom. 1:15-16).

I ask You to create a thankful heart in _____ especially in times of difficulty (*always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.* – Eph. 5:20).

I ask that _____ will labor from godly motives and not from a desire to please people (*Rather, we have renounced secret and shameful ways; we do not use deception, nor do we distort the word of God. On the contrary, by setting forth the truth plainly we commend ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.* - 2Cor. 4:2).

I plead, O God, that you would raise up strong believers around _____ who will encourage him/her in the tasks that God has given to him/her (*I do wish, brother, that I may have some benefit from you in the Lord; refresh my heart in Christ.* Philemon 20).

I ask that _____ would not grow weary in sharing the gospel but that _____ will know that if he/she does not lose heart he/she will reap converts to Christ (*Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.* - Galatians 6:9).
